Our program prepares candidates to teach multiple subjects in a self-contained classroom such as those in most elementary schools. Our teacher candidates are provided the tools to create diverse, inclusive, and equitable classrooms with an integrated approach to theory and practice. Our program is primarily a face-to-face program with courses beginning in the early evenings.

Application process is three steps:

- 1. Apply to the university
- 2. Enroll in prerequisites
- 3. Apply to the program

Step 1 – Apply to university

Apply as a graduate student at: calstate.edu/apply/graduate Requirements:

- · Bachelor's degree
- 2.5 GPA or higher required
- Good academic standing from previous university
- Meet professional, personal, scholastic, and other standards for graduate study
 Send your transcripts within 30 days & by deadline

Step 2 – Enroll in prerequisites

Upon receiving university admission, you may register for the prerequisite courses which can be found under Teacher Prep in the class search

EDTE 4100 – Teaching English learners & special populations

EDTE 4200 - Technology for educators
